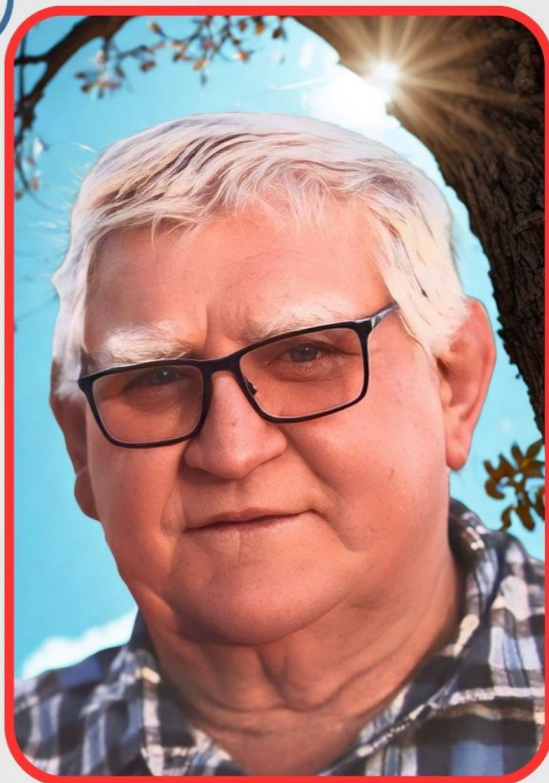


FAMILY TREE

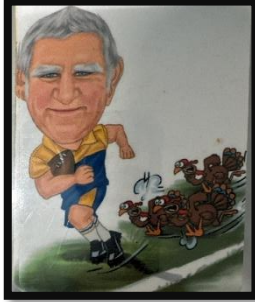
